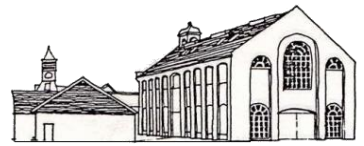

What is a 100 Club?

How will it help?

Our aim is to get 100 members, each paying £5 monthly. With gift aid this will help to generate nearly £5,000 each year. This money will be used to help restore the Long Shop in a project that will cost approximately £1.25 million. The project will

- Build a lift for the Long Shop – giving everyone access to this important space
- Introduce new displays interpreting this building and the local heritage
