Fredrick Mower 21st February 1907	C92	Foundry	16/ -	Loss of time. Paid off 18th May 1907
David Barker 22nd February 1907	A352	Boiler and Lathe Shop	15/ -	Loitering about. Fined 15/ -
Albert Hadden 26th February 1907	A455	Long Turnery	15/ -	Ill treated his wife. Paid off 22nd August 1907
James Dollimore 6th March 1907	A449	Long Turnery	24/ -	Left complaining about wages. 9th March 1907
George Grand 1st March 1907	A401	Long Turnery	6/ -	Left saying he was afraid to be at his machine. 21st June 1907
Frank Groom 13th March 1907	A596	Tool Room	15/ -	Spoiling work 28th September 1907
Charles Spink 18th March 1907	A545	Long Fitting Shop	15/ -	Spoken to for losing time, did not like this. 10th July 1907
Albert Woolnough 18th March 1907	D9	Paint Shop	6/ -	Paid off for playing about. 6th January 1907
Harry Smyth 20th March 1907	A379	Long Turnery	14/ -	Refused to work on night shift. 8th July 1907
Thomas Button 25th March 1907	B96	Machine Shop	20/ -	Joined Coal Strike. Paid off. 11th March 1907
Eli Whitely 12th April 1907	A302	Brake House	20/ -	Ran into shaft in traction engine. 27th August 1907
William Bridges 29th October 1907	A476	Erecting Shop	24/ -	Striking an apprentice. Paid off. 16th November 1907
